

Preface

The purpose of this document is to provide guidance and standards for GSDF members to obtain a GSDF license plate. Prior to applying for a license plate, Soldiers must meet certain requirements. Additionally, this SOP delineates who may authorize a Soldier to obtain a GSDF license plate. Review and revision of this SOP is the responsibility of the GSDF Headquarters, Chief of Staff, and may occur annually or as needed.

Chapter 1

GSDF LICENSE PLATE

GSDF License Plate

1-1. The state of Georgia has authorized Georgia residents who are members of the Georgia State Defense Force to apply for a Georgia State Defense Force (GSDF) license plate.

Motor Vehicle Division Fees

1-2. GSDF members are entitled to one (1) free license plate. Additional plates require a <u>one-time</u> manufacturing fee of \$25.00, <u>annual</u> registration fee of \$20.00, and <u>annual</u> special fee of \$25.00.

GSDF Requirements to Apply for License Plate

1-3. For the GSDF to authorize a member to apply for a license plate, the member must be in *good standing*.

Good Standing

- 1-4. The GSDF defines good standing as the member has:
 - Completed MEPS and IET.
 - Served a minimum of six (6) months of active service.
 - Received a recommendation from his Commander.

Procedures to Apply

- 1-5 GSDF members who wish to apply for a license plate must follow this procedure:
 - Obtain an application (see Appendix A) and complete Parts A-C.
 - Submit the completed application to their unit's HHC personnel (S-1 or HQ/HHC First Sergeant) for approval.
- The unit's HHC personnel then verifies the member is in good standing and submits the application to the appropriate personnel for approval. Each unit may determine who will approve the applications (i.e., the Commander, S-1, HHC Commander, and the like).
- 1-7 Upon approval by the appropriate personnel, HHC personnel scans and emails the application to G1SHOP@gasdf.us to obtain a control number from the GSDF License Plate Application Log.
- 1-8 The unit HHC personnel distributes the application as follows:
 - Original application to the member.
 - One (1) copy to unit files.
- 1-9 The service member then follows applicable Department of Driver Services procedures for obtaining the license plate.
- 1-10 If the unit personnel does not approve the application, he should provide a reason for the denial and a timeline for the member to reapply.

Discharge

1-11 When the member separates from his GSDF service or fails to maintain good standing, the HHC personnel must notify the G-1 to complete the Notice of Cancellation for Georgia State Defense Force license plate and submit it to the Georgia Department of Revenue, the Motor Vehicle Division, who then rescinds the license plate.
